

# Clinical Case

## Wound from Deep Partial-Thickness Burn



31-year-old female

**Relevant medical history:**  
Not specified

**RECELL treatment area:**  
Face  
**Total wound size:** 11% TBSA

**Treatment Info:**  
Hydrotherapy debridement, bacitracin and Xeroform® dressing (initial conservative care), intraoperative VERSAJET® debridement, temporary allograft to face



### Clinical Outcome

- **Day 6:** Dressings removed
- **Day 9:** 100% re-epithelialization, no signs of infection
- **Month 2-12:** Progressive re-pigmentation and close match to surrounding skin
